SUGGESTED COVERAGE AND PLACEMENT OF SPIKES

| TRUNK DIAMETER: | 4" | 6" | 8" | 10" | 12" | 15" |
| SPIKES USED: | 3 | 5 | 6 | 8 | 10 | 14 |

Place spikes into moist soil, equally spaced around the dripline (see illustration below).

For best results, place spikes at least 3' apart at dripline, and never closer than 2' from the trunk.

Hammer spikes to ground level using the plastic pounding caps. Remove cap and pound in at least 2 more inches.
