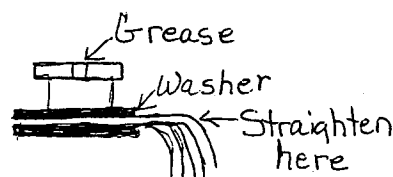


HOLT'S NUT WIZARD, INC.

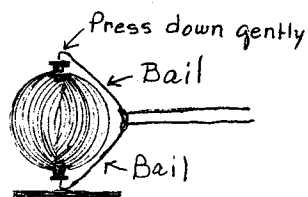
Holt's Nut Wizard is not a toy. It is a tool for gathering nuts. Do not roll **HARD** across the ground—you could damage the wire basket. By rolling **GENTLY**, the nuts literally jump into the basket. Do not **JAB** at the nuts or try to get them out of holes with the tool.

Be sure that your handle is tightened securely for it to work properly. The basket doesn't retain leaves and very little trash. If a stick gets into the basket, remove at once to keep from bending or breaking the wires. The wires cannot be replaced.

If a wire should break out on one end, carefully break out the wire on the other end at the edge of the washer. Using your fingers, just below the bend in the wire, space out your wires evenly. The wires need to be adjusted from time to time as you use your tool. This will help your tool do a better job for a longer period of time.



If the basket won't stay in the bail without falling out, turn the bail with one end on a table. Put the bail in and then press the bail down on the other end until the basket will stay and roll well. If it fits to tightly, the ends of the bail can be pulled gently apart.



The wire dumper fits on a 5 gallon bucket or similar container. The bracket legs fit on the outside of the bucket with the round dome inside the bucket. To empty the Nut Wizard, set the basket at a slight angle across the top of the wire, give a gentle shake and the nuts will fall into the bucket.

If tool begins to squeak after using, remove the basket from the bail. Clean out the holes in the top of the bolts that the bail fits in to. Grease each end with some multipurpose grease. Oil doesn't work well because it will not stay in the holes.

Store your tool in a way that it will not fall, preferably with the head down in a bucket to keep it from rolling off. Never let it roll in the back of a truck. The wires are very sensitive which help the tool to perform much better.

The Nut Wizard is built by hand. We examine each tool before it is packed. We work at producing the best tool possible. But nothing that is built by man will last forever. A tool that is properly taken care of will give you lots of good service. We guarantee it to do a very good job for you.
