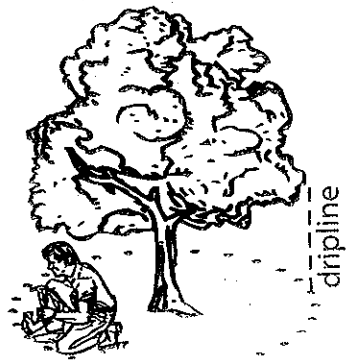

#### SUGGESTED COVERAGE AND PLACEMENT OF SPIKES

Place one Spike every 4 feet at outer edge of dripline. If deficiency is severe, reduce spacing to 3 1/2 feet. Spikes are either pounded into the ground using plastic caps provided, or dropped into the root zone after the Fast/Feeder makes 8" deep openings. Heel the holes closed.
