

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

TREEKOTE® EMULSION is applied cold with a stiff brush to fresh tree wounds, grafts, or pruning cuts in most any kind of weather except while raining or freezing. In order to maximize the proven benefits of tree wound dressing in reducing dieback and helping prevent the spread of harmful pathogens, **TREEKOTE®** should be applied as soon as possible. **TREEKOTE®** should be applied in a thin layer (more is NOT better!) paying attention to covering the wound edges without build up in the corner of the bark and exposed wound. **TREEKOTE®** will adhere firmly to all surfaces until forced away by developing callus on the margins of wounds or by the growth of the grafts, and there is no reason to re-apply when pushed away by growth or worn away by the natural elements. This emulsion dries quickly and when dry is not affected by climatic changes.

TREEKOTE® EMULSION is ready to apply as it comes from the container. If the material should become too thick and heavy to apply, add a small quantity of water and mix thoroughly until the mixture is moist enough to spread on in a thin coat while also achieving complete coverage.

STORAGE

Any reserve should be kept tightly covered to prevent deterioration through drying out. Before putting away it is best to cover the material surface lightly with water. Store where it will not freeze.
